Winemakers Tasting Notes: The Syrah varietal is Santa Barbara County's great noble red. Formidable and age-worthy, it excels beyond all measure in our county. This bottling is abundant with suggestions of blackberry, cherry and hints of pepper. Its silky texture carries ripe fruit and tannins on the palate.

Optimum Storage Conditions: Constant temperature, 55-58° F, darkness
Aging Potential: To enjoy young fruit aromas, consume within 1-3 years of bottling date. For extended aging under ideal conditions, consume within 3-10 years of bottling date.

Fermentation: Fermented in 1 ton macro bins
Aging: 100% French oak (41% new) for 16 months.
Unfiltered.
